GENERAL INFORMATION

Swimming New Zealand and the Banana Boat New Zealand Ocean Swim Series have partnered to host the 2022 NZ Secondary School Open Water Championships within the Generation Homes The Mount Swim.

The Championships will take place on Saturday 2 April 2022 at Mount Maunganui in Tauranga. The location and date of the championships has been updated on 2 March 2022, following the postponement of the Generation Homes Legend of the Lake event in Rotorua until the 21 May 2022.

Event Safety and Rules will be governed by the Banana Boat New Zealand Ocean Swim Series guidelines.

This meet is open to financial, registered (at the time of competition) Swimming New Zealand club swimmers, competitive swimmers and any person who is enrolled at Secondary Schools in New Zealand.

Distances, Age Groups and Eligibility

The event offers the following distances:

- 2.8km
- 1250m
- 500m

Swimmers wanting to enter multiple distances can do so at their own responsibility. Please note that swimmers must attend the safety briefing of each distance entered. Check safety briefings and start times before entering.

Age Groups for the Championships are 12-13yrs, 14-15yrs and 16-19yrs, with a female and male division for each of the above Age Groups.

Eligibility Age as at 2 April 2022

There are no qualification times for the Championships; entries open to all schools in New Zealand with year 9-13 students.

Homeschooled students are eligible to participate but must align to a secondary school for the Championships.

Please note that this event will be delivered under the current Covid-19 Protection Framework outlined by the government, and a condition of entry will be that all participants over the age of 12 years and 3 months will be required to present their My Vaccine Pass.

Late Entries will <u>not</u> be accepted. No refunds for any withdrawals (including medical) will apply once entries have closed.

Entry Process

All entries MUST be completed online and through the Banana Boat NZ Ocean Swim Series registration portal which can be found here.

School Sanctioning Form

All entries must be confirmed/sanctioned by the swimmers' Secondary School.

Following entries closing, schools will be sent a list of their students together with the Sanctioning Jotform, which must be completed no later than 5:00pm on Thursday 31 March 2022.

No international visitor entries will be accepted for this championship.

Withdrawals








Course Maps















Timing

Electronic timing chips and ankle straps will be used for the 2022 NZ Secondary School Open Water Championships.

Swimmers will be required to pay \$50.00 per chip if it is lost/not returned.

Swim Caps

Swim caps are provided as part of your entry and must be worn as a Health and Safety measure.

Wetsuits

Wetsuits are optional for all events.

Wave Starts

All events are split into wave starts (start groups) seeding you with swimmers of similar ability/speed. This is calculated by the estimated swim time selected during your entry process.

Rack Pack Collection

Race Packs can be collected at the Swimming NZ Registration Tent on the day of the event, Saturday 2 April 2022.

The following registration opening times apply:

2.8km; 7:15am1250m; 8:00am500m; 10:00am

Results

Results for the 2022 NZ Secondary School Open Water Championships will be posted on the SNZ website and Banana Boat New Zealand Ocean Swim Series as soon as practicable after the event.

Medals will be awarded to the first three (3) swimmers in each age

category per gender as part of the prize giving for each race distance.

A trophy will be awarded to the top overall school with points at the conclusion of the last medal presentation, allocated to swimmers' placing within each distance/event. Points are allocated as stated in the table below.

Please note that all NZ Secondary School Open Water Championship swimmers will still be eligible for medals for the Generation Homes The Mount Swim event in respective divisions, as well as overall series points. Those swimmers who are from the Aquaknights zone will also be eligible for zonal medals and school points since the event is hosting both championships in one.

Anti-Doping

All participants must agree to and comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.

Parking

Event Parking will be limited in the event areas, please allow enough time to park further away if required.

Bag Storage Area

An area designated to store gear bags will be available for all participants while you swim. This will be situated at the main event site at Mount Maunganui Beach. You will need to bring your own small bag and label with your name and contact details. Please remember, this is an 'all care, no responsibility service', so please do not pack valuable items.
