COVID 19 PROTECTION FRAMEWORK (TRAFFIC LIGHT SYSTEM)

We will be operating with the New Zealand Government 'My Vaccine Pass'. For all those who are over 12 years and 3 months, the 'my vaccine pass' will provide proof of your vaccine status and allow you to enter the building. This includes all swimmers, officials, volunteers and helpers at the meet. There will be no spectators.

Please ensure that you have downloaded your vaccine pass from www.mycovidrecord.nz in preparation for this meet. This will be checked before entering the building. You will be required to accept these terms and conditions of the meet before entering. If you are unable to download this pass then please have a physical copy of the pass.

If you are not fully vaccinated and do not have a New Zealand Government exception, you will not be able to take part in the JASI Christmas Cracker Meet.

Please note, if you accept the terms and conditions but are not fully vaccinated or you are unable to provide proof of vaccine status then you will not be allowed to enter the building and will not be eligible for a refund.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All registered competitive and club swimmers are eligible to enter.
2. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules. There are no qualifying times for Para athletes. Entries for para swimmers are to be e-mailed to admin@jasi.co.nz.
3. Age as at 9th December 2021.
4. Entry Fees are: Individual Entry = **\$8.00**, Distance Events = **\$10.00**, Relay Entry = **\$12.00** (GST inclusive.)
5. Individual entries are to be completed **on-line only** and close at midnight on Sunday 05/12/2021.
6. Relay Entries must be submitted with names of swimmers who are entered in an individual event. Relay Entries close – Midnight 05/12/2021 and are to be completed **on-line only**.
7. Qualifying times are in 25m times.
8. There will be no refunds on entry fees except as per the scratching rules.

9. There are no qualifying times for the 800 and 1500 Free, but these are restricted to athletes 12 years of age and over.
10. Swimmers entered in the distance events (800 and 1500 Free) are required to provide an official or timekeeper for Session 1.
11. JASI Swim Club reserves the right to restrict entries to ensure the timeline is adhered to.
12. Electronic Timing will be used for this meet. The use of electronic timing is still to be confirmed for the distance meet on Thursday (09/12/2021) This is subject to the number of entries and timeline of that session.
13. Submission of entries constitutes acceptance of these Meet Rules and Conditions.
14. Late entries will be at the Technical Advisor and/or Referees discretion based on, lane space availability, late entry fee \$20.00 per event, swimmers will not be eligible for prizes or points, these will be swum as exhibition swims only.
15. Please check names, entries and events are correct on receipt of confirmation. Corrections will only be made to entries where errors have occurred. Final psych sheets will be posted on the SCWC website and sent out on the Wednesday prior to the meet.

MEET RULES

GENERAL

1. The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's Competition and Event Policies in conjunction with the New Zealand Swimming Rules, except where local meet rules and conditions apply. This includes the SCWC Technical Suit Policy for all competitors 12 years of age and under.
2. Events will be swum as timed finals, mixed gender, seeded slowest to fastest, with the exception of the 50m events. These will be swum as prelims and finals.
3. Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the Technical Advisor and/or Referee.
4. Electronic timing will be used at this meet with 2 timekeepers per lane.
5. Over the top starts will apply for individual events.
6. Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ Regulation 4 accompanied with the \$100.00 fee.
7. Entry into the pool for backstroke events shall be feet first. No swim back is permitted.
8. Please exit the pool at the side. **Do not** swim over the lane ropes.
9. **Cameras and Photography**

SCWC and/or the host Club may take photos and videos may be taken during the meet: all spectators and athletes agree to allow photos, video and audio recording to be taken by an SCWC approved and/or accredited person to be used for any legitimate purposes by SCWC and/or the meet organisers. Any concerns should be directed to the meet organisers. Spectators agree upon entry that photographic, video or audio recording equipment is prohibited for any purpose, with the exclusion of personal cell phones. The meet organisers will, at their sole discretion, determine whether or not an item which could be used for the purposes of taking photos, video or audio recordings is permitted for use during the meet. Photos remain copyright of the approved/accredited person.

SCRATCHING'S / WITHDRAWALS

1. Scratching's for the first session must be submitted by **12:00pm (midday), Wednesday 8th December 2021** to admin@jasi.co.nz
2. Scratching's for the 50m Opens Finals must be made within 30 minutes after the results are posted.
3. For subsequent sessions scratching's must be submitted no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the session immediately prior to the session in which the scratching is to be effective.
4. Swimmers will be deemed to have withdrawn if they do not report to the marshal at the appropriate time prior to their event and the withdrawal fee will apply.
5. A \$20.00 fine will apply without excuse to all late or non-scratching from events.

WARM UP

1. As per Swimming Canterbury West Coast warm-up procedure guidelines
(Warm-up is the responsibility of the clubs, coaches and swimmers involved).

Officials are not responsible for managing or controlling the warm-up procedures.

MARSHALLING

1. Marshalling will be outside the sports pool.
2. All swimmers must marshal for their events.
3. Swimmers should be in the marshalling area six (6) races prior to their event for distances of 200m and under and at least four (4) races prior for 400m and above distances.
4. There will be self-marshalling for the 800 and 1500 Freestyle events.

AGE GROUPS

50m Events = 13 & under, 14 & over.

100m, 200m and 400m Events = 13 years & under, 14 – 15 years, 16 years & over.

In mixed events, the fastest 8 male and 8 females will race their gender in the last 2 heats.

RELAYS

1. Relay team names must be submitted with names of swimmers who are entered in an individual event.
 - a. All relay swimmers must compete in an individual event at this meet to be eligible to compete in the relays, if a swimmer swims up an age group for a relay in the **meet**, they may not swim for their own age group relays as well. Mixed relays must comprise 2 male and 2 female swimmers.
2. Any changes to the entered relay swimmers' names must be with the Control Room **30 minutes** prior to start of the session in which the relay is to takeplace.
3. Russley Trophy, 10 x 50 Medley relay, 1 Back, 2 Breast, 3 Fly and 4 Free and must be swum in this order. Each team must consist of 10 swimmers and must comprise 5 male and 5 females.
4. In event 3 + 4 (4 x 100 IM Relay), each swimmer in the relay team will swim 100 IM and **NOT** swim it as a medley relay (100Back, 100 Breast, 100 Butterfly, 100 Free).

SPECTATORS

Please note that due to Health and Safety Requirements and competitor numbers there may be no spectator seating inside the Sports Pool. If you wish to watch your child's race you will need to do from the Rec Pool side of the complex. **PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS AT DISCRETION OF THE CCC.**

AWARDS

1. Medals will be awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd male and female in each age group.
2. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th – 8th place in each of the 50m sprint race finals.
3. Towels awarded to relay winners and ribbons for 2nd and 3rd place.
4. Russley Trophy presented to the winner of the 10 x 50 medley relay.
5. Prize Money will be awarded as follows to the winner of the combined points, across all four 50m finals.

Officials Convenor to advise all those officiating at the meet that they are required to report to the referee at the start of warm-up please. Referees IOTS & the Chief Timekeeper need to report in plenty of time. Earlier than the start of warm-up is preferable.

As per the Swimming New Zealand Regulations there is a minimum number and standard of officials required for a meet to be classed as approved and for those times to be considered for regional or national event qualification. The ‘Minimum Officials for Approved Meets’ sheet must be completed for each session, signed by the Referee and sent to the region. The region must, within seven (7) days of the completion of the meet forward the meet results and officials sheet/s to SNZ.
