#### TROPHY RACES TO BE CONTESTED

Note – these trophy events are for Competitive Swimmers only

**Jacobs Cup** 4 x 50m Freestyle – 2 males & 2 females aged 12 yrs & under.

**Thames Cup** 4 x 50m Freestyle Relay – 1 Male & 1 Female under 16 yrs and 1 Male & 1

Female under 14 yrs.

**McNamara Trophy** Female – 4 x 100m Freestyle – any age.

**Noumean Trophy** Male – 4 x 100m Freestyle – any age.

**Adam & Eve Trophy** 2 x 50m Freestyle Relay aged 13yrs & over.

Teams to be selected by draw from the top 8 female and top 8 male 50m freestyle results at the Waikato Senior Championship meet - each team to consist of one male and one female. Selected swimmers will be notified by email of their selection into one of the Adam & Eve teams so they can confirm their attendance at the Relay meet prior to meet closing. Selection for this event will be based on the swimmer's age at the Waikato Senior Championship meet.

**Little Adam and Evette Trophy** 2 x 50 m Freestyle Relay – 12yrs & under.

Teams to be selected by draw from the top 8 female and top 8 male 50m freestyle results at the Waikato Junior Championships - each team to consist of one male and one female. Selected swimmers will be notified by email of their selection into one of the Little Adam & Evette teams so they can confirm their attendance at the Relay meet prior to meet closing. Selection for this event will be based on the swimmer's age at the Waikato Junior Championship meet.

#### **TOP CLUB (LARGE AND SMALL)**

All races (excluding the Trophy Races) will be points races, with the top eight finishes in each event earning club points. Overall points achieved by each club will be divided by the number of swimmers competing from that club to establish the overall Top Club.

Swimming Waikato Competitions are conducted under SNZ and Swimming Waikato Regulations with the following conditions and criteria.

PLEASE NOTE: With the exception of the Trophy events, this will be an unapproved meet.

No individual times will be recorded.

Eligibility: Entries for relays are open to Waikato Clubs and Visiting Clubs. All swimmers taking part

will be COMPETITIVE or CLUB swimmers who are registered in the SNZ database and are

financial as at the date of the meet. Qualifying times are not required.

Closing Date: Closing date for all entries is **Sunday 8 February 20189** at 11.59pm.

Age: Age as at the first day of the meet (with the exception of the trophy events where swimmers

will compete in their age as ag 31 December 2018) Swimmers may swim in their own age group, plus the next age group up, eg. a 12 year old may contest a 12/under relay event and also swim in a 13/14 age group. Any swimmer may contest an Open age event.

Mixed Club Entries: If a secondary hub club is unable to enter a full team, they are able to enter combined relay

teams within their Hub:

Coastal: Coromandel, Mercury Bay, Paeroa, Waihi and Whangamata Swimming Clubs.

Central: Cambridge, Huntly, Morrinsville and Te Aroha Swimming Clubs.

Southern: Marlin, Otorohanga, Piopio, Putaruru, Te Kuiti and Tokora Swimming Clubs.

Clubs who wish to make entries in accordance with this provision will need to arrange between themselves which club is responsible for submitting entries. Combined relay teams

will not attract any point allocations.

Entries: Clubs are to EMAIL a list of their relay entries to <a href="mailto:cherie@swimmingwaikato.co.nz">cherie@swimmingwaikato.co.nz</a> before the

closing date. Where a club has more than one team entered in an event, the teams are to

be named A, B, C etc.

Swimmers names are to be confirmed, again by email, by 5.00pm on the Thursday preceding

the meet.

Each club can enter a maximum of four teams in each event.

Fees for a late entry shall be \$30 per team. No late entries will be accepted in the Control

Room without payment of the correct fee.

Entry Fees: \$20 per team entry incl. GST.

Swimming Waikato will invoice each club for their total number of relay teams after entries

close.

Withdrawals: NO REFUNDS for any team withdrawals (including medical) will be given once entries have

closed. All withdrawals for the Relay Meet are to be received in the Control Room 45

minutes before the start of racing.

Protests: Protest fee = \$100. Payable upon submission of correctly completed protest form. Only the

Championship events are eligible for protest.

Athletes with a Disability:

Athletes who hold a Para Classification are eligible to participate in this programme and can

swim alongside able-bodied athletes. It is the responsibility of the athlete with a disability (or their Team Manager) to inform the Referee before they swim of their IPC Classification and to supply the Referee with their Para Classification Card. Where applicable, the

Referee will use their best efforts to judge the swim under the applicable IPC Rules.



**Timed Finals:** All events are timed finals.

Timekeepers:

Coaches, Managers & The names of the Team Coaches, Manager and Timekeepers (as set out in the Timekeeper allocation sheet) are to be forwarded by email to <a href="mailto:cherie@swimmingwaikato.co.nz">cherie@swimmingwaikato.co.nz</a> by the 18<sup>th</sup> of February 2019. This will give these people access to the Waterworld complex without incurring the entry fee.

Marshalling:

There will be no marshalling. Swimmers are to be marshalled by their Club Team Manager at their lane just before the start of their event. No races will be delayed if swimmers fail to appear for their event.

**Trophies:** 

The Trophies contestable in this event are listed on the cover of the meet flyer.

In addition, a Trophy will be awarded to the overall Top Clubs (large and small). All races (excluding the Trophy Races) will be points races, with the top eight finishes in each event earning club points. Points allocation will be as follows -

A large Club has **21** or more individual swimmers taking part. A small Club has **20** or less individual swimmers taking part.

- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the Technical Director.
- Participants who have entered this event agree to allow photograph, video, multimedia or film likeness taken by accredited photographers to be used for any legitimate purpose by Swimming Waikato.
- Timekeepers names are to be provided to Swimming Waikato along with the meet entries.
- Entry into the pool for backstroke events shall be feet first. No swim back permitted.
- Please exit the pool at the side. Do not swim over the lane ropes.
