Eligibility

- 1) Students competing must be enrolled full-time in the school they are representing.
- 2) New Zealand students competing must be a Year 7 or Year 8 student.
- 3) New Zealand schools must be an affiliated member of NZAIMS New Zealand Association of Intermediate and Middle Schooling http://nzaims.co.nz
- 4) Students may compete in more than one code however, timetable allowances will NOT be made for any competitors.
- 5) Competitors must be Over 10 years and Under 13 years of age as at the 1st January of the tournament year (2018).
- 6) Competitor's birth-dates will be required on future team registration documentation.

Entry Information

- If registration is oversubscribed, then the slowest ranked swimmers will be withdrawn first.
- Sport Coordinators; please indicate clearly on the online Anchor AIMS Games registration page the number of swimmers per Age Division/Gender Division by Wednesday 13th June.
- Swimmers compete based on their age at the start date of the competition.
- Swimmers entries must be entered through the Swimming New Zealand website by the swimmer's parent/guardian by Wednesday 1st August.
- Swimmers may only enter 7 events plus the relays
- Short course times (however long course converted times will be accepted)

Para Athlete

All Para swimming races will be run as multi class events with all classifications swimming together. Places in each race will be determined based on comparing each swimmers time to the World Record in their classification. The swimmer with the time closest to their world record as a percentage will place first and so on.

All Para athlete registrations must be accompanied by a provisional classification supplied by Paralympics New Zealand. Forms to apply for a Provisional classification can be found here: http://www.paralympics.org.nz/Pathway/Classification/Classification-Forms

Although there are no qualifying times, all swimmers must be proficient in the chosen strokes. The strokes being offered at the Anchor AIMS Games in 2018 are:

- 50m free
- 50m back
- 50m breast

Para Swimming Classifications:

The sport classification names in Para swimming consist of a prefix S, or SM and a number. The prefixes stand for the event and the number indicates the sport class the Para athlete competes in during the respective event.

The prefixes stand for:

S: Swimming (Freestyle, Breaststroke and Backstroke events)

SM: Individual Medley

Sport Classes 1-10: Physical Impairment

There are 10 different sport classes for Para athletes with physical impairment, numbered 1-10. A lower number indicates a more severe activity limitation than a high number. Note that Para athletes with different impairments compete against each other, but the impact of their impairment on swim performance is similar.

Sport Classes 11-13: Visual impairment

Para swimmers with visual impairment compete in sport classes 11-13, with 11 meaning a complete or nearly complete loss of sight and 13 describing the minimum eligible visual impairment. Para athletes in sport class 11 compete with blackened goggles.

Sport Class 14: Intellectual impairment

Para swimmers with intellectual impairment who also meet the sport-specific criteria compete in sport class 14.

Medal Presentation

- Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in each event per Division (as soon as possible after each event poolside on finals night).
- Relay Cup awarded to the winning school with combined points from the 4 x 50m Freestyle and 4 x 50m Medley will be couriered to the winning school.
- Top School Cup awarded to the winning school with combined points from the Individual Finals (Points are 1st = 11, 2nd = 9, 3rd = 8, 4th = 7 and so on), will be couriered to the winning school. If by chance there is a joint winner for the Overall Top School Award, the winner will be decided on individual winning positions; ie the more 1st places won, the greater the chance of receiving the Overall Trophy.
- Medal table points will only be counted from the overall point's medal winners for Division 1, Division 2 and Division 3 Boys and Girls, the two relays and the top school points.

Meet Director

The committee will appoint a Meet Director to whom general complaints can be directed. Any complaints must be lodged in writing to the Meet Director within 15 minutes of the completion of the race and accompanied by \$100.00. The Team Manager is the only person who may approach the Meet Director on a matter of disqualification or ruling.

Rules

The Anchor AIMS Games Meet will be conducted under the technical rules of FINA with local rules taking precedence including the following:

- The Organising Committee reserves the right to determine the number of Officials.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to restrict the number of entries or combine events where necessary.
- Swimmers must be registered with a club that is affiliated to their National Body.
- Electronic timing will be used for this meet.
- The Monday heat programme and pool entry passes will be in the manager's packs to be collected from the Arataki Community Centre on Monday 10th September at 10.00am.
- Events will be swum as per the programme over the page however the Organising Committee reserve the right to restrict the number of entries for any event or combine events where necessary.
- The fine for failure to withdraw from a final is \$50.00.
- The Freestyle Relay can be made up of any Year Group or Gender Division swimmer only one team per school.
- The Medley Relay can be made up of any Year Group or Gender Division swimmer only one team per school.
- For School Team Points and Relays all swimmers must be enrolled full-time in the school they are representing and all teams must be school based.
- All team managers are required to have their team's medical forms with them throughout the week.

Venues

- Swimming Championship Venue Baywave TECT Aquatic and Leisure Centre is a 25-metre pool.
- Strictly NO deck chairs permitted at Baywave.
- Swimming Managers Meeting Venue Arataki Community Centre, Zambuk Way, Mt Maunganui (next door to Baywave).

Baywave Spectator Entry Fee

Anchor AIMS Games swimming spectators (anybody aged 8 years and over) will be charged \$2.00 per day. Spectators will pay the \$2.00 entry fee at Baywave reception, and will receive a pass so they can come and go as much as they like during that day.

2018 Planning Timeline

- Wednesday 30th May Para Swimmers (without existing classifications) must submit Provisional Classification forms to the Paralympics New Zealand classification manager.
- Wednesday 13th June Entries close for the 2018 Anchor AIMS Games at 11.59pm. The AIMS Games Trust has a strict NO REFUND policy from this date! NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Wednesday 27th June All schools must have paid their registration invoice to have their entry confirmed (Late entries (if accepted) will incur a 50% penalty fee).
- Friday 29th June Confirmation sent to all 2018 participating schools (if registration for a sporting code is oversubscribed then the opportunity to compete will be at the discretion of the executive committee).
- Monday 2nd July School group opening ceremony ticket bookings go on sale through Ticketek (3.00pm Show 1 and 7.00pm Show 2).
- Monday 9th July Public opening ceremony tickets go on sale through Ticketek (3.00pm Show 1 and 7.00pm Show 2).
- Wednesday 1st August All Team/Individual online name and code information registration forms to be completed (to meet code draws and tournament booklet printing deadlines). Details of swimmers first name, surname, date of birth, gender and swimming club will be required to be completed by the school.
- Wednesday 15th August All swimmers event entries must have been completed by their parent/guardian on the Swimming New Zealand website (times are updated automatically).
