- Entries Close:** Saturday 6th March 2021 at 11.59pm via FAST LANE on Swimming NZ.

Maximum of FIVE entries per swimmer.
- Entry Fees:** \$8.00 per event. No late entries.
- Entry Times:** All times to be converted to LC. NT's not accepted.
- Age Groups:** 10/U 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16/O. Age as at 14th March 2021.
All events will be swum as timed finals.
- Programme:** Programme will be posted online prior to the event – this is a paperless meet.
- Officials:** Clubs are requested to supply 1 IOT as well as 1 timekeeper per 4 swimmers entered.
Please supply names by 8th March 2021.

- Withdrawals:** SCM Withdrawal rules will apply as follows: ALL withdrawals must be lodged in writing at least 30 mins prior to the start of each session. Any entrant not complying with the above will be deemed a late withdrawal and may be fined \$30.00 per event.
- Refunds:** Refunds on medical grounds will only be given when a medical certificate, signed by a medical practitioner, is supplied.
- Para swimmers:** Classified para swimmers (including provisional classification) are eligible to compete at this meet for events that they hold an approved time. Para-swimmers are requested to report to the Technical Director prior to the warm-up of the first session that they compete at the meet.
- Strapping:** Swimmers with strapping must provide signed documentation from a health practitioner or physiotherapist to the Technical Director prior to swimming. Any swimmer without signed documentation will not be permitted to swim.
- Protests:** Protests must be submitted to the referee, in writing, on the protest form by the team manager only within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event. This needs to be accompanied in cash by the \$100.00 protest fee. If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the event a protest must be lodged before the signal to start is given. All protests shall be considered by the referee. If the referee rejects the protest, they must state the reasons for their decision. The Team Manager may appeal the rejection to the Jury of Appeal whose decision shall be final. If the protest is rejected, the deposit will be forfeited to SCM. If the protest is upheld the deposit will be returned.
- General Info:** Papakura Swimming Club reserves the right to restrict event numbers if entries exceed the nominated time frame.
- The pool is certified - 50m length & depth 1.6 > 1.2m.
- Semi-automatic timing will be utilised.
- The Meet will be conducted under SNZ's rules, regulations, by-laws and FINA rules.
- Papakura Swimming Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal belongings during this Event.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- In entering this event, participants agree to allow photograph, video, multimedia or film likeness taken by accredited photographers to be used for any legitimate purpose by Swimming Counties Manukau, their sponsors or others.
