MEET CONDITIONS & INFORMATION

This event is conducted under SNZ and ASA Regulations with the following conditions and criteria.

Eligibility: Entries are open to all registered competitive swimmers.

Qualifying Period:
There is no qualifying period for the Auckland Christmas Cracker.

Individual Entries:
Converted entry times will be accepted.
Timed finals will be seeded slowest to fastest.
Entries may be restricted to ensure the smooth running of the event.
NO TIME (NT) entries will be accepted.

Closing Date: Individual Entries close on Monday 20th November 2023 at 11.59 pm.
Relay Team Entries close on Tuesday 21st November 2023 at 11.59pm

No late entries will be accepted.

Age: Age as at 2nd of December 2023.

Individual Events

Age Groups: 10 & U, 11, 12, 13/14, 15 & O

Relay Events

Age Groups: 10 & U, 12 & U, 14 & U, Open

Entries: To be entered directly into the SNZ Database

Entry Fees: Individual Entries:
\$15.00 incl. GST. (Payment to be made via credit/debit card at time of entry)

Relay Entries:
\$50 per team (entitles each team to enter all 5 relay events)
Relay members must have swum two individual events

Withdrawals: NO REFUNDS for any withdrawals (including medical) will be given once entries have closed.
All withdrawals for Session 1 are to be received at kate@swimmingauckland.org by noon Tuesday 28th November 2023. Withdrawals for Sessions 2, 3, and 4 must be into the AOD control room no more than 15 minutes after the end of the preceding session or emailed to kate@swimmingauckland.org. The same time frame applies to all email withdrawals.

12/U Athletes: Please note that the ASA Tech Suit restriction applies to these events.

Relays: All teams must contain the same team members for all 4 relays.
The mixed teams must be 2 Females and 2 Males.
Relay members must have swum two individual events

Awards Individual

Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded to the first 3 placegetters in each age group in each event.

Awards Relays

Cash Prizes will be awarded to the mixed team with the fastest aggregate time across all 5 Relays for each age group.

10 & U \$100

12 & U \$120

14 & U \$200

Open \$300

There will be prizes awarded to the 2nd and 3rd teams in each age group.

Protests:

Protest fee = \$100. Payable upon submission of correctly completed protest form.

Warm-up Supervision:

It is an ASA requirement that all swimmers are supervised during warm-up by an NZSCAT accredited coach. This is to ensure the Health and Safety of all swimmers during what can be a chaotic time. If your coach is not attending the meet then you need to arrange a coach from another club to supervise your swimmers during warm-up. Parents / Team managers are not permitted to supervise swimmers during warm-up.

Starts:

Timed Final events will be swum as 'Over the Top' starts and the FINA One Start Rule (SW 4.4) will apply.

Pool Deck

All swimmers must display an ASA accreditation card.

All Team Managers must be on the SNZ Database and Police vetted.

Officials must wear their ASA Officials shirt or an ASA accreditation card and be police vetted.

Coaches must display their NZSCAT accreditation.

No access to the poolside area will be permitted without valid accreditation.

Athletes with a Disability:

The ASA has a "mainstreaming" policy relating to athletes with a disability. Athletes who hold a Para Classification are eligible to participate in this programme and will be seeded amongst able-bodied athletes on the basis of entry times. It is the responsibility of the athlete with a disability (or their Team Manager) to inform the Referee before they swim of their Para Classification and to supply the Referee with their Para Classification Card. The Referee will use their best efforts to judge the swim under the applicable IPC Rules.

Member Protection Policy:

SNZ operates a Member Protection Policy.

All participants in this meet agree to be bound by the conditions of this policy as a condition of entry.

All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.

In entering this meet, participants agree to allow photograph, video, multimedia or film likeness taken by accredited photographers, to be used for any legitimate purpose by Swimming Auckland, their sponsors or others.
